



RESERVATION POLICIES

EFFECTIVE 4/5/2022 UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

- **All guests are required to show proof of COVID-19 vaccination to dine at Blue Heron. All guests aged 12+ must show proof of full vaccination (two doses of Moderna or Pfizer or one dose of Johnson & Johnson). Children 5-11 must show proof of one dose of vaccine. When you arrive for your reservation, you will need to show a CDC vaccination card or a digital image of your CDC card. All guests 18+ will be asked to show identification along with proof of vaccination. An individual who refuses to show proof of vaccination may not enter.**
- Masks are optional. Please be mindful of social distancing when not wearing a mask.
- Reservations are required for all parties, including seats at the bar; please call ahead.
- Reservations are available from 5-9 pm. All tables are given a two hour time limit (if you require a longer time, please indicate at the time of requesting reservations).
- All parties of 5 or more require a credit card number to hold the reservation. If you do not call in advance to cancel your reservation and do not show, your credit card will be charged a \$35 per person "no call, no show" fee.
- Regular outdoor dining is closed for the season. You are welcome to indicate on your reservation a preference for outdoor dining if there happens to be a mild evening, but otherwise your reservation will be held for inside.
- All tables are positioned so to maintain approx. 4 foot distance from all other tables. We ask that customers remain seated while on our premises to reduce the spread of respiratory droplets. Please keep your children seated at the table at all times.
- All indoor dining areas are equipped with HEPA certified air purifiers. To increase ventilation, weather permitting, we may have open windows or doors in the dining room.
- If you arrive early for your reservation, please stay in your car until the time of your reservation (bar seats are reservation only). You may call from your car if you arrive early to see if we are able to seat you early.
- Alcohol-based hand sanitizers with at least 60% alcohol are provided at entrance/exit and on each table for your use.
- Do not come if you are feeling unwell, including COVID-19 symptoms (fever of 100.3 or higher, shortness of breath, cough, new loss of scent or taste) as well as any symptoms that could generate respiratory droplets, including a cough or sneeze from allergies.
